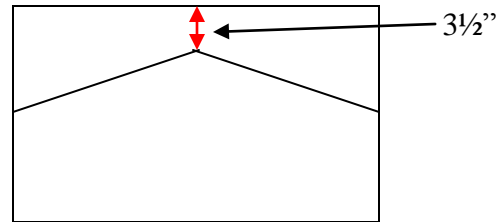
New Mexico Veteran's Art / Chamisa Hills Art Exhibit

Chamisa Hills Country Club in Rio Rancho is an exhibit venue with ample wall space of varying proportions, a busy clientele, and scheduled meetings. Full-sheet framed watercolors and other sizes down to 10" wide can be hung. Columns in a large dining room have space for 20"- wide pieces. Any art that can be hung on walls will be accepted: framed art, flattish wall sculpture, textiles, stained glass work hung from chains, etc.

Curator Mikki Roth will supervise the show hanging and some of us volunteered to help her on May 3, when we bring in the work. Mikki stressed that work should not be erotic or controversial, nor so small that someone might walk off with it. (The club is not responsible for damage or theft.) Enter your best work, as Mikki said if the work is not up to Club standards it would not be hung. We aren't jurying entries; she will decide.

It's important that work be properly framed and presented. This doesn't mean "expensively framed." Work can use Neilsen frames and plain white mats. Below are tips on framing.

- * Use wood or metal frames. Maximum size around 26" x 32"
- * If possible, use white or off-white mats, although colored liners are acceptable.
- * Either glass or Plexiglas is acceptable, but most exhibits now insist on Plexi to avoid accidental breakage. (The Club will not be responsible for damage to artwork.)
- * Hanging wire in back should peak at 3½ inches from the top of the frame to assure tops will be even.
- * Work can be for sale and the Club takes a 10% commission. In the event of a sale, the Club will issue you a check and call to see if you wish to replace the sold work.

Bring work to studio between 8 and 9 a.m. on May 3.

We will take work to Chamisa Hills by 10 a.m. on Mon. May 3. Protect work in bubble wrap or bring flattened box cardboard to place between paintings. **Make arrangements for getting work there if you cannot.** (If you live closer to Chamisa Hills than Terry's studio, take artwork to Chamisa Hills at 10:00.)

Fill in, cut out and attach to upper right side back of your work as identification.
